Finance Update — as of 3/31/2024

Finance Update (preliminary figures as of March 31, 2025)

General Giving tithes & offerings were approximately \$16,000 greater than budget for the first three months of the year. This is primarily associated with timing, as several families made multiple-month donations during this time period, as opposed to spreading them out evenly throughout the year. This resulted in a bottom-line surplus of roughly \$8,000 through the end of the first quarter 2025. As a reminder, the annual budgeted deficit is \$67,000.


