DR. ANDREW S. ERB, CONDUCTOR



Dr. Andrew Erb has been a music educator in the Western Pennsylvania area for 28 years and is currently the Director of Bands and Professor of Music at Grove City College. He directs the “Wolverine” Marching Band, Symphonic Concert Band, Wind Ensemble, and coaches the trumpet ensemble, and brass quintet. He also teaches brass methods, woodwind methods, orchestral literature, wind band literature, jazz history, and assists with student teacher observations.

Dr. Erb remains an active adjudicator, guest conductor, and presenter in the region. He has presented workshops at both PMEA and OMEA events, served as an adjudicator for large ensemble assessment festivals in Pennsylvania and Ohio, and guest conducted both PMEA and OMEA honors, district, and region band festivals. He was recently selected to present at the annual PMEA Conference in April 2024 and at the regional PMEA Professional Development Day in March 2025.

An active trumpeter, Dr. Erb holds the principal trumpet chair with the Greenville Symphony Orchestra and performs with 2nd Avenue Project, Pipe Dreams, and the Youngstown Fine Arts Brass Quintet. He is a member of the Northwest Passage Trumpet Trio whose first album, “Expeditions,” received rave reviews in the International Trumpet Guild and the American Guild of Organists Journals. The trio performed at the International Trumpet Guild Conference in Miami, Florida in July 2019, and was featured in recital during a live radio broadcast on WQLN, Erie, in November 2019. Dr. Erb has performed as a freelance trumpeter with Ben Vereen, Wayne Newton, Marie Osmond, Lena Prima, and Tony Butala, and appeared with the Commodores, Average White Band, Bobby Blue Bland, Foreigner, and Kansas.

Dr. Erb holds a bachelor’s degree in music education from Westminster College, a master’s degree in trumpet performance from Youngstown State University, and a doctorate in music education from Boston University. Dr. Erb lives in West Middlesex with his wife Diana and their children: Jonathan, Benjamin, and Madison.
